<b>Purpose(s) 2022-23</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To identify obstacles – academic, behavioral, social/emotional – to effective teaching and learning and identify research-informed solutions for improvement.</li> <li>2. To review student performance data from state and local assessments and identify gaps and underperformance of subgroups to review associated action steps/plans.</li> <li>3. To review the implementation of the IB DP and MYP programs and the impact on student access and success.</li> <li>4. To periodically review any challenges to instructional or library materials.</li> <li>5. To monitor the implementation of Illustrative Math so as to determine if additional resources/support are needed for successful teaching and learning.</li> <li>6. To monitor the Graduation Measures Project from NYSED to determine what, if any, steps the District should consider in response to policy changes.</li> </ol>
<b>Committee Goals for 2022-23</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To monitor through committee and Board of Education reports the development of the Program Plan for Students with Disabilities, the development of the MTSS Framework, the review of the K-5 Literacy program, the implementation of the DEI Plan, the revision of the District Professional Development and Mentoring Plans, and the development of the personnel management structure for meeting the 2022-23 District Goals.</li> </ol>
