The committee discussed the current status of the projected budget gap based on known expenditures and revenues at this time. The administration discussed the variables that are still being reviewed and will provide additional details to the committee in the coming weeks. Administration noted that of local districts surveyed, most are considering going to the maximum tax levy under their respective tax caps with many considering a reduction in staffing.

ii. Impact of CVA Settlement

The committee discussed the remaining balance of the Child Victims' Act settlement agreement and options for how the district can provide the funding for this beyond the established reserve.
