Minutes

Present: Ms. Stringer, Ms. Bass, Ms. Lucasey (ex officio), Dr. Clamser, and Mr. Slentz. The meeting convened at 4:30 p.m.

1. Framing the work

Committee

a. Review and approval of agenda *The committee approved the agenda*

2. Updates and Recommendations

Administration

- a. 2023-2024 Budget Updates
 - i. Overtime billing status

In response to the recent audit by the NYS Comptroller's Office, Dr. Clamser updated the committee on current overtime status in the facilities department and the controls that have been put in place to monitor overtime. The committee discussed the processes involved in assigning and paying overtime, and the anticipated improvements that will come with the addition of new staffing under the restructuring of the facilities department.

b. District Audits

i. Internal audit preliminary meetings

Dr. Clamser updated the committee on the recent visit from the internal auditor from Nugent & Haeussler, P.C. The auditor reviewed district records, including recent audits, to determine the levels of risk of various financial activities in the district. The auditor will meet with the audit committee in the new year to deliver his risk analysis and recommend a focus for this year's internal audit.

ii. Comptroller audit Corrective Action Plan (CAP)

Dr. Clamser presented the draft CAP in response to the recent audit by the NYS Comptroller's Office regarding overtime in the facilities department. The plan will be presented to the board on December 19 for approval and will be submitted to the NYS Education Department within the required timeframe.

c. Tax Certiorari claims status

Dr. Clamser provided the annual tax certiorari claims summary and explained the current status of claims and the anticipated payment amounts. The committee discussed the age of some of the claims and the processes in which a judgment was made, a settlement was reached, or the claim was removed. The committee also discussed the level of funding in the tax certiorari reserve fund relative to the sum total of current claims.

d. 5-year Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility

Dr. Clamser reviewed the data on free and reduced meal eligibility and discussed the direct certification process through which the vast majority of our students and families are determined to meet the criteria. The committee discussed the implications of the percentage of students meeting eligibility.
